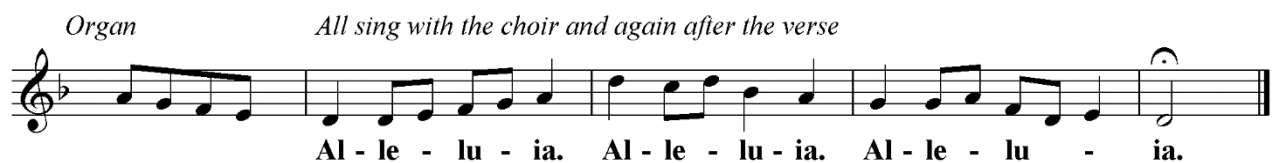

THE AFFIRMATION OF FAITH

**We believe in one God,
